A purchase at the Livestock Auction represents your dedication to the success of our future leaders and bolsters future involvement by school aged children in agricultural programs that are both fun and educational.

The auction is the culmination of months of hard work and preparation that brings together animal and exhibitor in competition. We would like to invite you to register as an auction buyer and join us as the best of the best are presented in the auction ring. Your purchase and support will acknowledge a job well done. The premiums received by the youth are often invested into furthering their livestock project's, college educations, and other worthwhile ventures with in our community

If you are unable to attend this year's auction we hope that you will still support the youth of our county. We would be happy to make a purchase on your behalf. Please contact one of the auction committee chair's below and they will be able to give you information on how this process works.

The livestock sale will be using the **premium buying method**. Premium buying method is where you pay the premium amount, without retaining ownership of the animal. This formula will hold true for all species, except hams. The sale bill will signify which animals are available for slaughter. If you so choose, you may meet with any of the youth that have animals for slaughter after the sale to purchase an animal for this reason. If you need help locating an animal that is for sale, please inform someone at the sale registration table they will be happy to assist you. This transaction will solely be between you and the individual selling the animal for slaughter. **On all purchases of animals for slaughter, the buyer will be responsible for making arrangements with the seller for slaughter and payment!**

A list of youth and their parents that are registered in ham and livestock projects will be added to this website after registrations have been received. As in previous years, buyers will be asked to write all checks to the Randolph County Youth Fair.
